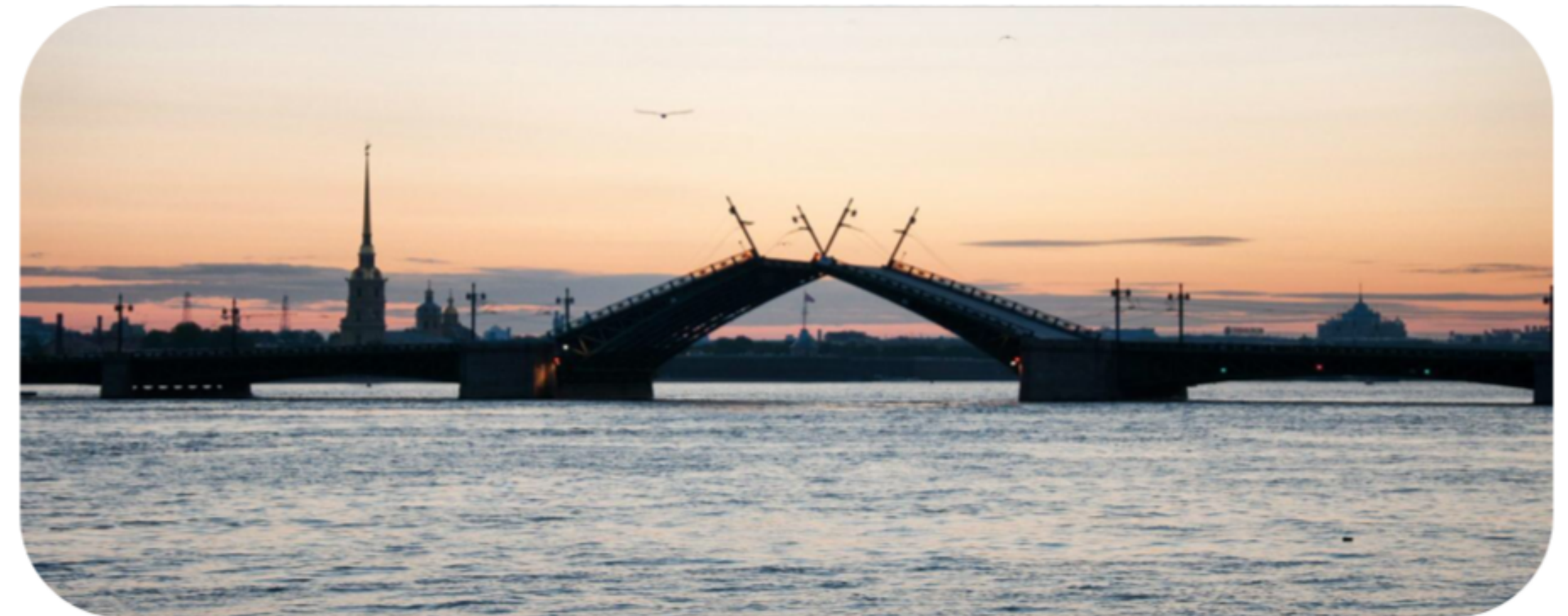

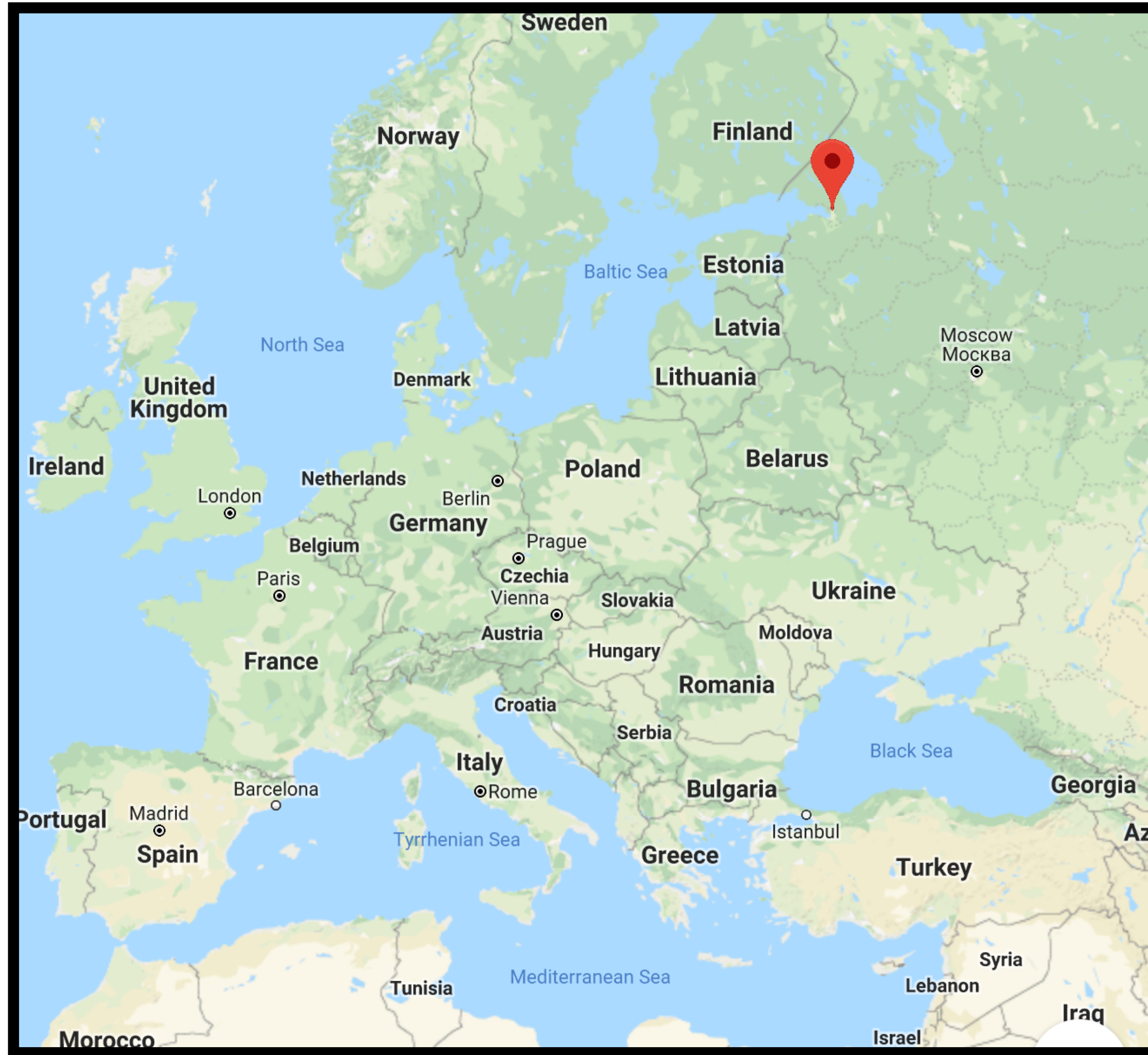
EuroCG 21: Basic Info

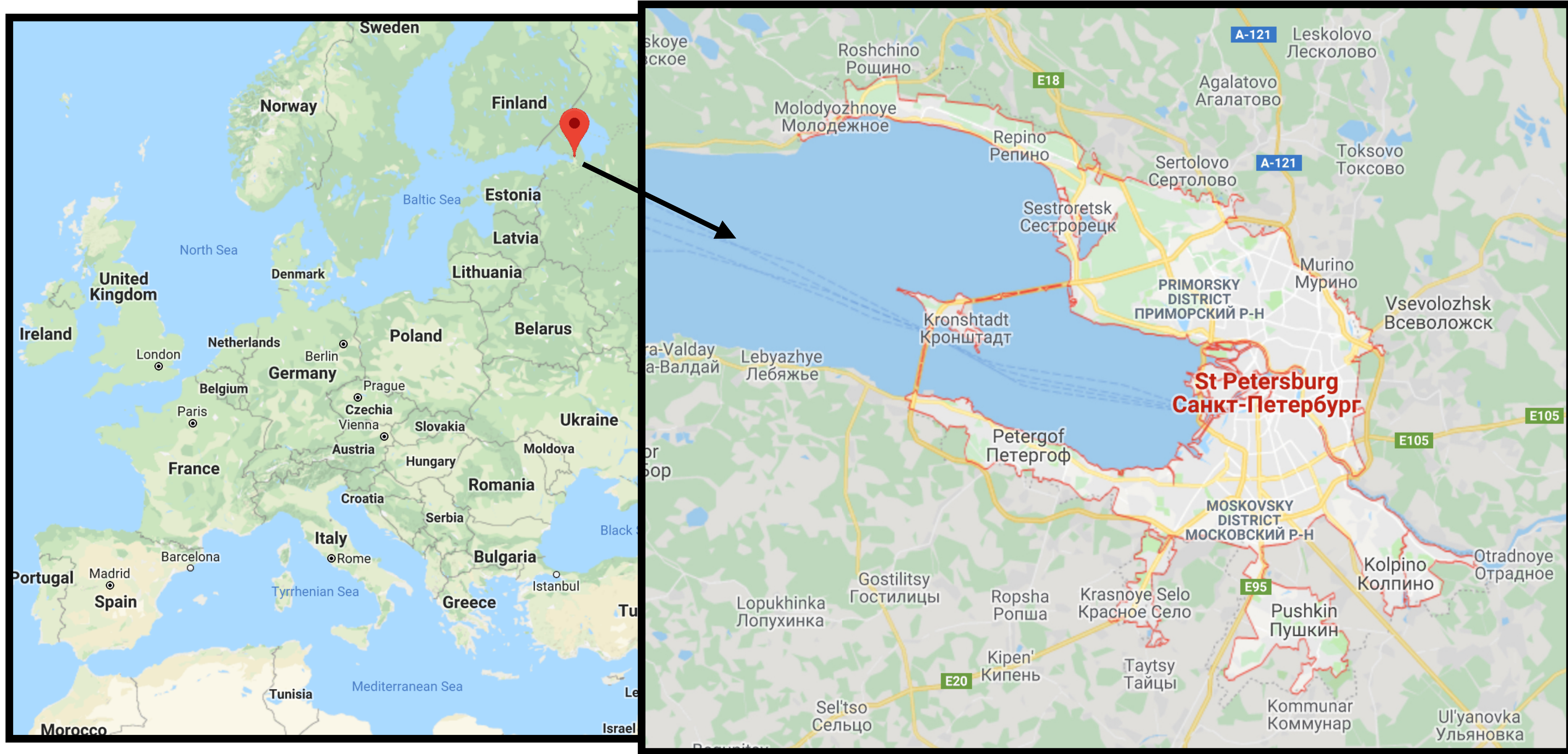

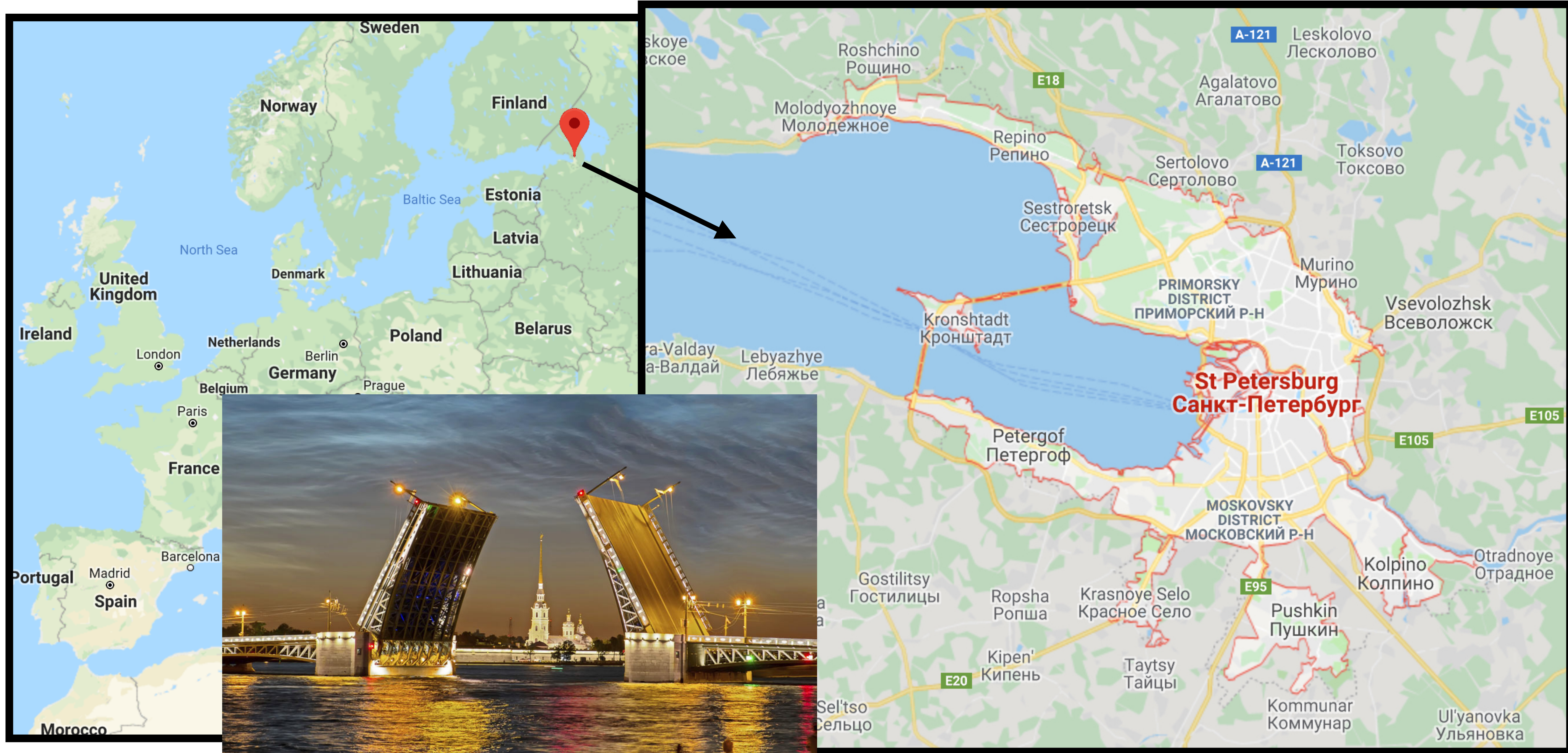

Getting there*

- **By plane:** Pulkovo airport (LED) 25 km from the venue.
Return flight from any major city in Europe:
~**150-270 euro** with 1 connection
~**250-350 euro** direct
- By train: 5 railway stations (connections to Europe).
Direct high-speed train from Helsinki (Finland) 4 times a day ~**30-60 euro**
Possible to go by train from Warsaw, Paris, Berlin, etc.
- By Bus: direct connections with Finland, Latvia, Lithuania, Estonia
- By boat: Direct regular connections with Helsinki, Stockholm, Tallinn.

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Accommodation*

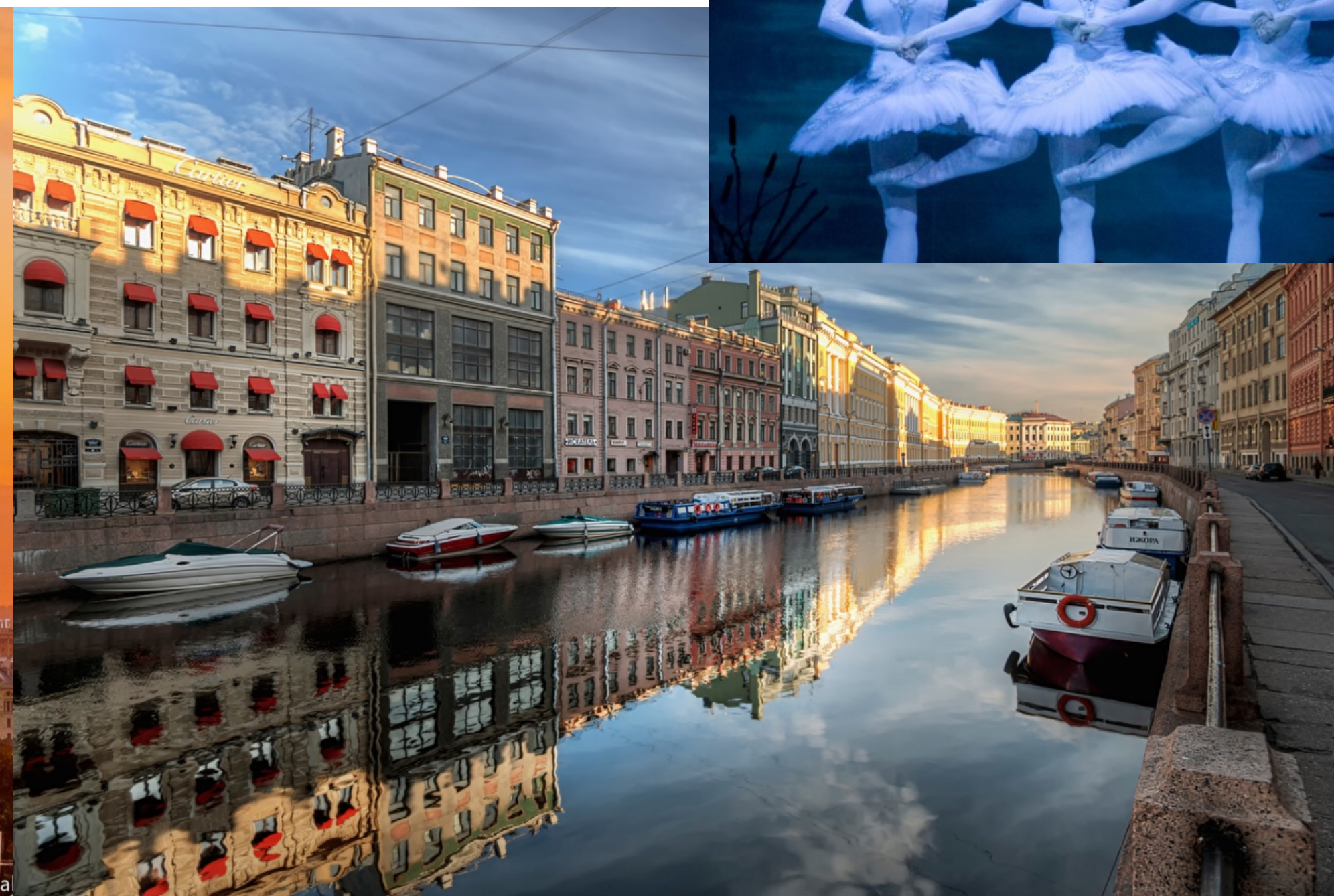
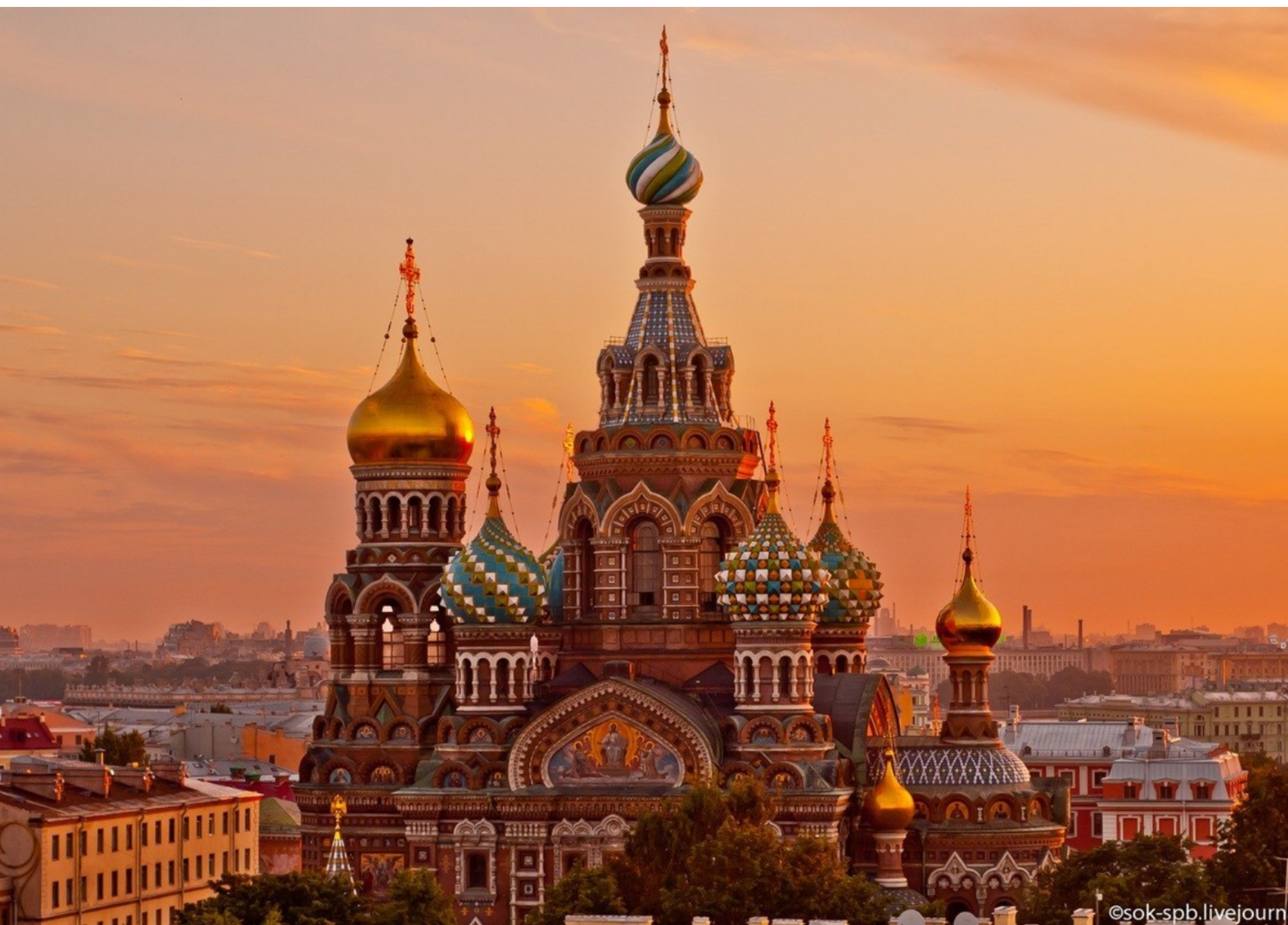
- Hotels:
 - 3-star: **25-60 euro/night.**
 - 4-star: **70-130 euro/night.**
 - 5-star: **from 120 euro/night** to infinity :-)
- Hostels: **15-30 euro/night**
- Apartment/room rentals of all levels (e.g., Airbnb)

Enjoying Saint Petersburg

- Rich cultural life: theater, museums, music
- Strong historic background: have seen 14 tsars, the cradle of 3 revolutions and home to artistic and liberal intelligence
- Unique architecture: a UNESCO heritage site
- 44 islands, 86 rivers and canals, bridge draw
- Vibrant night life



Weather in April

- last 5 years this time: +4 — +12 Celsius (can be rainy, or even snowy)
- Beware of humidity: e.g., same temperature may feel colder than normally

- We advise to bring a woolen overcoat, a scarf, a hat, tough boots, and gloves.

Visa to enter Russia/SPb

- E-visa: free and fast (4 working days)
coming for ≤ 8 days,
only to the area of SPb,
NOT by train (plane, car, bus, boat, by foot ;)
for citizens of EU, India, North Korea, Mexico, Japan, etc.
